CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Participation will be restricted to those people/organisations approved by the Rotary Club of Hillarys (Inc) and who agree to abide by the following conditions:

1. The Rotary Club of Hillarys (Inc) is not liable if the Fair is postponed or cancelled due to weather or any other reason.
2. Each application will be processed once the completed application form and supporting documents are received. All successful applicants will be notified within four weeks. Should there be too many applicants for any particular type of stall, the Rotary Carine Community Fair committee reserves the right to decline your application. Preference will be given to long term participants of the Fair. No refunds will be given for late cancellations or 'No Shows'.
3. **All stalls (selling food items such as cakes, olive oil, jams etc.), food and coffee vans are required to supply, in their application, their City of Stirling 12 month trading permit number.**
4. **Details of power supply requirements are to be completed on the application form. An additional fee is payable when power is required and ALL participants requiring power must provide their own suitable power leads and fittings, which have been tested and tagged within the last 6 months by a licensed electrician.**
5. Each stall/amusement/food and coffee vendor is responsible for the setting up and the removal of their power supply systems and for the safety and security of them.
6. Stalls/amusements/food and coffee vendors must be set up by 9am and removed by 6pm on the day of the Fair. The grounds must be cleared as soon as possible on completion of the Fair. No responsibility will be taken for items left at the fairground overnight before or after the Fair. **For safety reasons stalls/amusements/food and coffee vendors must remain in operation until 4pm.**
7. Stalls/amusements /food and coffee vendors are individually responsible for compliance with the applicable By-Laws of the City of Stirling and for leaving their stall area in a clean and tidy condition. (see City of Stirling website for details).
8. All stalls/amusements/food and coffee vendors are required to have Public/Products Liability Insurance for the day of the Fair. For stalls that do not have insurance, cover can be provided through Rotary. See application form. Conditions and fees apply. Rotary is not responsible for damage, loss, theft or personal injury.
9. The Rotary Club of Hillarys reserves the right to request the removal of products from display and sale if they are deemed unsafe, inappropriate or offensive.
10. The Rotary Club of Hillarys (Inc) may add to, amend, remove, or modify any condition set out herein. Such changes will be notified to the representative named on the application form.
